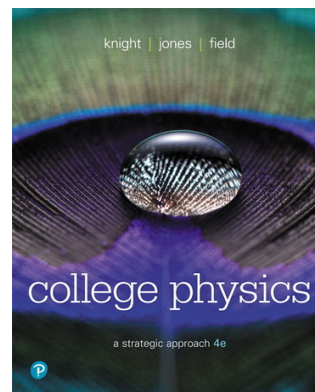


2021-2022 AP Physics 1: Summer Assignments
