

## STUDENT FEES 2020/2021

**ANNUAL STUDENT FEES** FOR THE 2020/21 SCHOOL YEAR ARE AS FOLLOWS AND **ARE DUE IN FULL BY JUNE 15**. LATE CHARGES WILL APPLY: **Payment may be made via the Parent Portal.**

- Activity/ Extracurricular:** Covers student activities such as special events, LRC after school supervision, set-up/clean-up for school dances and activities, security for school events, stipends for club moderators, student free admission to all regular season home sporting events, etc.
- Parent Club:** Covers Parent Club activities including hospitality at school events, fundraising activity costs, etc.
- Yearbook:** Covers the cost of the student yearbook.
- Technology:** Covers the costs associated with the parent portal, smart boards, licensing fees for on-line resources in the Learning Resource Center, computer technology infrastructure, etc.
- Retreat:** Covers the costs associated with retreats. For juniors it also covers the cost of overnight lodging, meals & bus transportation.
- Graduation:** For seniors only, it covers the cost of caps and gowns, graduation ceremony, award ceremonies, etc.

**iPad Lease Fee**

Due Upon Receipt of Invoice – \$250  
This fee covers the leasing of the iPad for the academic year. Payment by May 18<sup>th</sup> will allow current students to retain use of their iPad over the summer. iPads will not be issued until paid. Electronic text books are not included in this cost. Payment of this fee is payable via the Parent Portal

**Electronic Text Book Fee:**

Due Upon Receipt of invoice. Current year fee is anticipated to be \$160. This fee is subject to change. This covers the cost of the ebooks or ibooks that are uploaded to the iPads. Payment of this fee is payable via the Parent Portal.

**Other Discretionary Fees:**

**Fine Art Fee:**

- Art:** This fee covers the art supplies and consumable materials for all art classes. This course fee is \$35.  
**Band:** This fee covers the sheet music and band supplies. This course fee is \$35. Payment of this fee is payable via the Parent Portal.

**Athletic Fee:**

Students may participate in multiple sports throughout the school year and pay only one fee.\* The fee varies by sport with the sport in the highest of the three tiers being the applicable fee due. Tier I is for Boy's Lacrosse, Football and Golf. This fee is \$285. Tier II is for Soccer, Volleyball, Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Wrestling and Girl's Lacrosse. This fee is \$210. Tier III is for Tennis, Track, Cross Country, Cheer and Dance. This fee is \$155.

**Insurance Fee:**

Required of all students who participate on a school sports team. The insurance fee is \$30 (\$60 for football)\*

**NOTE: The Athletic and Insurance Fee applies once a student is on roster for a sports team. Payment is due upon receipt of invoice.**

**NOTE: Individual coaches/teams may request payment for team specific items. These payments are handled by the coaches.**

*\*Excludes Hockey and Rugby which are club sports.*

**Parking Fee:**

Students who drive and park must purchase and display a parking tag in order to use the school's parking lot during the class day. The tag fee is \$144 (reduced by \$36 per academic quarter for students who start parking later in the school year).

**IMPORTANT:** School fees are handled separately from tuition and should be paid by check or cash (ie. not deducted via ACH debit.)  
These fees are due in full upon receipt of invoice.  
Please include your student's name on all payments to insure proper crediting to your account.

**Fundraising Fee:**

\$100 minimum fundraising requirement per *family* supporting development efforts. More information on how a family can meet the minimum fund raising requirement will be provided during the school year.
