Freshmen Reminders

Freshmen students must read the book they received entitled *I, John Baptist De La Salle*. They are to write a letter to Mr. Beirne explaining why they want to attend Montini, what they expect to accomplish, and what they will contribute to the school community. Freshmen are to bring this letter to their Quest 2022 experience on Thursday, August 9th. On Friday, August 10th freshmen will attend a mandatory I-Pad Academy Day. The day begins at 9:00 and ends at 2:00, lunch will be provided.

Incoming freshmen must have a copy of their birth certificate on file in the Main Office by **August 1st**. This copy must be a certified issued certificate from the County. Hospital issued certificates will not be accepted. Incoming freshmen must also have a current physical form with up to date immunizations on file. IHSA physicals are **not** acceptable for freshmen.

Senior Reminders

Senior parents please make note that graduation is scheduled for Sunday, May 19, 2019, at 10:00 a.m.

All seniors are required to show proof of having received one dose of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV) on or after their 16th birthday. Proof of this immunization is required by the first day of school (August 14th). Students will not be able to attend school without proper documentation of this vaccine.

Uniform Sale—Wednesday, July 11th, 9:00am—11:00am and 5:00pm – 7:00pm

There will be a Used Uniform Sale for polos, slacks, sweatshirts and fleeces. Gently used uniforms will be accepted until July 10th in the Main Office. Please pin your name on each piece; otherwise we will consider the items donated. Prices will be as follows: Polos (short & long sleeves) - \$5; Slacks - \$5; Sweatshirts & fleeces - \$10 and up. Schoolbelles will also be on campus to measure students and take orders, from 9:00 am to 11:00 am.

NOTE: Only sweatshirts and “Fleeces” purchased through the Spirit Store may be worn. No team wear may be worn except on Spirit Day Fridays. Hoodies are only allowed on Fridays.

Reminder: When shopping for school shoes make sure that you purchase dress shoes that are not backless and are solid black, brown, navy blue or cordovan.

Quest 2022, Freshman Orientation

Quest 2022 will be on Thursday, August 9th from 8:30am—2:30pm. This is a mandatory freshman orientation. Dress is casual; shorts are allowed. Lunch will be served to the students. Freshmen will need to turn in their letter to Mr. Beirne explaining why they chose Montini, what they expect to accomplish in their four years at Montini and what they can contribute to our community. Transfer students will meet in the LRC at 10:30.

Parents, guardians and host parents are encouraged to attend this meeting on Wednesday, August 8th at 7:00pm in the Auditorium. Students are not required to attend this meeting.

MyMealTime

Quest Food provides services to our cafeteria. Students can use their ID cards to purchase items in our cafeteria or pay with cash. Parents may deposit funds on their student's account via MyMealTime.com. Funds may also be added to the MyMealTime account through the Business Office or Main Office with payment in the form of check or cash only. Credit and debit cards are not accepted in the cafeteria for payment. Please allow **24 hours** for payments to be posted to your student's account. Please stress to your student that they **must have** their ID in order to receive their meal, unless they are paying with cash. You may view your student's account history any time on the MyMealTime.com website. Athletic Registration and Tryouts

The Athletic Office has a new registration and tryout procedure beginning this school. Registration and tryout information will take place on the "8To18" website. All student/athletes **must** register using the "8To18" website. More information will be available shortly.

Fall Sport Tryout Information

In order to try out for a Fall Sport, you must have an IHSA Pre-Participation Examination on file by **August 1st**. Times of tryouts will be announced later in the summer, however, please note that Football will begin official practice on Monday, August 6th and all other Fall sports will begin on Wednesday, August 8th.

Lockers and Picture Day

Lockers will be assigned on Picture Day, Monday August 13th. You may bring personal items (books, notebooks, etc.) for your lockers in order to be ready for the first day of school.
